


Concord House is an accredited Foster Home serving children and adolescents residing in Jackson County who need short-term planned and crisis respite treatment services.

Concord House (est. 2016) is a treatment foster care home developed to provide short-term planned and crisis respite treatment foster care for children and adolescents who reside in Jackson County. The goal is to reduce unnecessary psychiatric hospitalizations that can be traumatic for the child, and far from home.

The program is staffed with live-in, certified foster care parents who provide supervision and support for the children and adolescents—in a home-like atmosphere.

Concord House is located

east of downtown Medford in a charming neighborhood that is surrounded by beautiful, mature landscaping. It offers seclusion and serenity in a quiet community while still being close to shopping, restaurants, parks, schools, community services, and activities.


The home is newly remodeled with granite countertops and custom finishes as well as all new appliances. There is a large, private backyard for outdoor activities and a patio area for dining.

Families are now able to be involved with the child to be an active part of the solution, reducing family disruption, and improving outcomes.

Screening, certification, training and oversight of the Concord House foster parents is provided by Family Solutions, a leading children and young adult

services provider in southern Oregon. Referrals for the program are processed through Jackson County and Family Solutions.

Who is Served? Concord House has the capacity to serve up to two (2) children/adolescents ages 4-18 who are either experiencing a psychiatric crisis, or who face environment stressors such that they need a safe, structured, yet home-like atmosphere while the mental and behavioral problems that threaten to disrupt their home situation are treated.
