



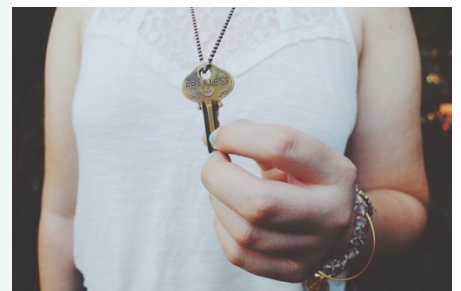
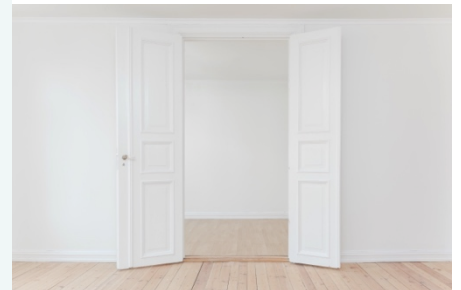
Supportive Housing

For Jackson Care Connect Members

Supportive Housing programs are non-licensed residential programs that can offer safe and stable housing along with varying levels of support depending on the needs of the Member. ColumbiaCare has contracted with Jackson Care Connect to develop and provide exclusive use of in-home services for those who have a mental health concern; who are in need of housing and support services.

Members are identified and referred through the Jackson Care Connect, and admission is a collaborative process between ColumbiaCare and the referring entity. Unless otherwise arranged, Members will be responsible for providing their own food, clothing, transportation, personal items, and medication. ColumbiaCare staff provide periodic health and safety visits per 24-hour period that, whenever possible, coincide with medication schedules. ColumbiaCare also provides a layer of safety and supervision – through documented visits, as well as on-call availability. Professional staff may provide therapy, skills training, psychiatric services, health services, case management, and other therapeutic services as needed to facilitate successful community integration.

Please note: Supportive Housing for Members is based on unit availability.
