Meadow Wood (est. 2010) is a part of a unique group of low-income, supportive housing programs designed around the needs of Veterans and their families.

Meadow Wood consists of 8 individual condos located inside the Meadow Wood Condominium Park, directly on RVTD bus line, and just two blocks from shopping and a main grocery store. The condos are located in a beautiful setting with mature trees and

professional landscaping, as well as access to a community lawn area, gym and pool.

ColumbiaCare accepts applications through various referral sources for these HUD approved condos. Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing vouchers are gladly accepted.

ColumbiaCare seeks to coordinate with Veteran's services programs and other community agencies to conduct outreach to Veterans who would benefit from this type of housing program.

ColumbiaCare Services acts as a mental health-friendly landlord, which means we carry out our property management duties with the understanding that a

Veteran's outlook, needs and behavior may have been seriously impacted by their military service – and are supportive during their rehabilitation process.

Our supportive housing program provides a safe, affordable, and stable home for local Veterans and their families, as well as family counseling that compliments the treatment the Veteran may be receiving.



Who is Served? Eligible persons are Airman, Soldiers, Sailors, and Marines – and their families – who are experiencing behavioral health or readjustment needs. Colonial Estates welcomes referrals from the Veterans Administration, and other sources for Veterans who are in need of some support in readjusting to living in the open housing market. This program provides a wonderful environment for Veterans and their families to focus on stabilization and community integration.
