Supportive Housing Program



**Morrow Bunkhouse** (est. 2006) is a unique supportive housing duplex that serves residents who are stepping down from licensed residential treatment, or other higher levels of care. For many individuals, being able to live at “the Bunkhouse” is a wonderful achievement and evidence of their hard work and commitment of recovery.

Morrow Bunkhouse is a two-bedroom home that is located on the same property as Columbia River Ranch (but not right door) to one of

ColumbiaCare’s licensed Residential Treatment Facilities.

The home is privately situated on 5 acres of rural farmland, providing plenty of space and tranquility for those residing there. There are two private bedrooms, shared kitchen, living room, laundry room, patio and yard.

Residents live semi-independently providing for most of their own needs, such as doing their own shopping and preparing most of their own meals. Residents of Morrow Bunkhouse commonly work or attend school.

Mental Health services are provided by Community Counseling Solutions (CCS), based on individual needs of each client, and admission is arranged through

CCS.

In addition Columbia River Ranch’s professional staff are nearby for assistance and support.

This program provides a wonderful environment for individuals who are still in need of some structured support but wish to be independent as they continue to work on their recovery.



**Who is Served?** Residents are individuals who have a severe and persistent mental illness, yet have demonstrated that they can live and function successfully in a more independent living environment, with proper supports. Tenants are able to manage their mental illness and recovery process, and most activities of daily living. Morrow Bunkhouse provides a wonderful step-down opportunity for residents of Columbia River Ranch, however; referrals from the community are welcome as well.
